Dear parents/carers,

Our residential is fast approaching and we are really looking forward to visiting Ashworth Valley Scout Camp.

Please arrive at school at the usual time of 8.50am on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June. Your child should come to school wearing their own clothes and a raincoat, these should be comfortable clothes for walking and doing activities in. All the children's belongings will be taken to Ashworth Valley for them, so they do not need to carry them on public transport - including their water bottles. Please try to limit your child's luggage to 1 large backpack where possible. We will return to school on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June in time for you to collect your child at our usual home time 3:15pm.

Your child will need to pack:

- A change of clothes for Friday
- A spare change of clothes (just in case)
- Underwear
- A spare pair of socks and shoes
- Pyjamas
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush etc)
- Small towel
- Refillable water bottle
- 1 black bin liner for wet / dirty clothes
- An after dinner snack e.g. crisps, chocolate (No nuts!)
- A teddy (optional)
- A book (just in case your child wakes up early)

Although the Lodge has heating, bedding is not provided so your child will need a sleeping bag. If you have additional sleeping bags, please consider loaning to a friend. If you have any problems about this, please speak to a member of staff no later than Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June.

In case of cold/hot weather your child may want to bring gloves, woolly hats, bed socks, scarves, sun hats and sun lotion etc.
