Draw an animal that lives in a hot or a cold country.

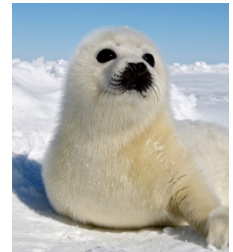
Do you know any facts about that animal?
