Membership at Bury Music Centre is offered, with opportunities to join our renowned orchestras, bands, ensembles and choirs. 

How it works:

- If a pupil begins music lessons after a half term break the relevant fee for that term will be halved.
- If your child's music lessons are paid for by the school through pupil premium or GCSE funding, please make this clear when registering.
- We offer a 7.5% discount to families paying over £300 per term.
- In the event of a local lockdown we will deliver online lessons.
- Lessons will only begin/resume once payment for the full term is received. **This payment is non-refundable.**


