Please accept our apologies, we will not be opening HP Club to Nursery age children. Children in receipt of an EHCP will be considered on an individual basis

A selection of sports activities will run throughout the day led by Mr Knowles and Miss Higginbotham e.g. football, netball, rounders and athletics. Miss Quirke will lead morning drama workshops. The school hall will be open throughout the day, with continuous provision of indoor play - board games, lego, big screen cartoons etc. for children who may need a short break from the sporting activities. Please note, the primary focus of activities available will be external sport fun and drama.

Places will be confirmed on a first **booked and paid** basis; and we do require a minimum number of children to attend to make the club viable. We also only have a set number of places available each day, so once booking is open, please do not delay if your child would like to come and enjoy the fun!

- After Club will include a light snack of toast and a drink of squash/water
- Children are required to bring their own packed lunch and a refillable water bottle
- A daily cash tuck shop will be available (morning and afternoon)

2. Once the required number of children have booked onto the Club, a payment request will be added on to the Scopay system. Without payment, the place will be retracted and offered to the next child on the waiting list. We will take payments via Scopay, via Childcare Vouchers, via Childcare Grant Scheme or via Tax Free Payments. We are not currently registered to the HAF voucher program.

As HP Club will be an extension of the wrap around care provided by Heaton Park Primary School, it will be run under the school's Ofsted number, and make use of all current school policies.
