



Covid 19 Home-School Safety Agreement

The school will do its best to:

Reduce risk of transmission of COVID-19 to the lowest possible levels;

Maintain and review risk assessments on a weekly basis;

Put measures in place to prevent direct transmission and indirect transmission of COVID-19;

Follow national and local guidance;

Meet each child's needs within school;

Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;

Inform you if staff or children in your child's group show symptoms of COVID-19

Communicate between home and school through text service, telephone calls, updates and the school website

To support opening of the school:

I understand that I cannot randomly opt in and out of the place offered;

If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and we will begin to self-isolate for 14 days as a family or until any tests for the household are returned as clear;

I will ensure any household member is tested immediately;

I will follow national "Track and Trace" instructions;

I will ensure that emergency phone numbers held by school are up to date and working;

If my child, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;

Only one person from my household will drop off or pick up my child;

I understand that I must leave the premises as soon as possible to allow for timetabling of other groups

I will stick to the 2 metre social distancing rules in the school grounds and follow Gov't guidance when away from school:

I understand that groups have been created for where social distancing is not possible in school;

When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings and allocated entrance for my child as per school protocols and organisation:

I will prevent my child from bringing any items into school or taking any items home;

I will need to help my child to understand all safety rules;

I accept and will stick to the school plans as set out in communications, so that my own child, other children and school staff are not put at risk;

I will not enter the school without a pre- arranged appointment;

I will not make payments in cash;

I will read all communications that are sent home;

As stated in government guidance, I will make sure my child does not bring in sanitiser or wear a face mask in school.

I understand that If my child is putting safety at risk, the place will be withdrawn

I will do my best to:

Follow rules throughout the school;

Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;

Not touch other children's equipment;

Keep within my own group in school;

Only enter and exit the school building from the correct door for my group;

Stick to the times and timetable for my group;

Follow good hygiene rules, coughing and sneezing into school tissues (elbow if no time);

Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;

Understand that if I do not follow these expectations I cannot come to school until I can keep other people safe.
