## Music in EYFS

Music is taught in a variety of fun and expressive ways in our EYFS. Children listen to and are encouraged to sing along during daily nursery rhymes and learn number through song which gives them the opportunity to express themselves, make sounds and explore rhythm and repetition. Children will be encouraged to remember and sing songs, sing the pitch and the melodic shape of familiar songs. The Charanga programme supports music in EYFS where some topic based songs are used. Children are familiarised with the structure of the Charanga programme in readiness for Year 1 where it begins being used for the majority of music lessons then will continue to be used throughout their school life.

Music stations with a variety of different soundmakers and instruments are located throughout EYFS where children can explore the different sounds of instruments and express their creativity freely in the continuous provision.

Music is used frequently to support the learning of phonics including listening and repeating sounds.

Children engage in music in dance through their PE lessons where they can perform solo or in small groups.
