Please find below a selection of useful dates and information for the Autumn term.

Go **RED** for dyslexia – October 6th

On Wednesday October 6th, all children are welcome to come to school wearing red (please no football kits) to raise awareness of dyslexia. Fun sessions will occur in class throughout the day. This is not a general non-uniform day, however please do not feel like you must purchase any red clothing especially – red socks or a red hair tie will do the job!

Pre-loved Uniform – October 7th and monthly

On the first Thursday of every month we will once again be starting up our pre-loved uniform sale after school, the first one this term will be this Thursday, October 7th. All items have been washed and are ready for their new homes, with a suggested 50p per item donation to school fund.

If you have any clean logo items of uniform which you would like to donate to the sale, the school office will be happy to receive them (please no white or grey uniform).

Health Update & Flu Vaccinations – October 8th

The difficulties around testing seem to be improving and I know that where necessary families have been able to access tests. Please can you ensure that your children are tested if they show any of the Coronavirus symptoms and are kept at home until you have a result. The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Tests should only be booked for those showing Coronavirus symptoms, and not as a precautionary measure. If you are unsure please call NHS111 or visit <https://111.nhs.uk/covid-19/>

Flu vaccinations will be available for all children who completed online consent from Reception to Year 6 on Friday October 8th.

Pupil Photographs – October 13th

The school photographer will be in school on Wednesday October 13th to take individual pupils' portraits. We will automatically photograph siblings together, though unfortunately we cannot accommodate other family relations. School Trips

Heaton Park prides itself on the experiences we have provided to pupils over the years, ranging from external visitors in to class to residential stays - there is no denying the added value they provide and the positive benefit children gain. Each experience is costed not for profit, and more than likely school has already subsidised a good amount of the price before asking for a parental/carer donation to cover the rest. Unfortunately, in academic year 2020/21 we received very few parental contributions to the many trips we ran, in fact school had provide an additional £9372 to balance unpaid trip costs across the year. As a school, we have not been able to fundraise since our Christmas Fair of 2019, and so this is a big hit on our already stretched school budget. Although we understand finances have been difficult for many, contributions are necessary if we are not to cancel future experiences.

School payments – Dinners / Out of School Care / Nursery Fees

Many thanks to the vast majority of families who keep up to date with their school payments. All payments should be made in advance and not retrospectively. Where retrospective payments are unavoidable, please ensure school is aware of the situation. Unfortunately, we cannot allow arrears to build up beyond a two week period. Any arrears covering two weeks or more may result in your child not being able to continue to access school meals, or run the risk of losing their Out of School or Nursery place.
