## Challenge 6

#### Challenge 4

Practice rhyming with day to day objects. See how many rhyming pairs you can make.

Think about the different seasons in the year (spring, summer, autumn and winter). Discuss what changes occur during the seasons. How are the seasons different? What is the weather like during the different seasons?
