Here are 8 Learning challenges: throughout this term you must complete 6 of these challenges (1 challenge per week). Please be as creative and inventive as you can to make these very interesting!

Please remember to read at least twice a week with your child. Books are to be signed and returned every Monday.

Challenge 1

Phonics Practise – We have now covered all Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds. We are now consolidating all of these in class. Please see our website for all of the sounds and continue to practise them regularly at home.

Continue to practise reading Phase 2 and Phase 3 tricky words. Follow these links for helpful songs.

Challenge 3

Our learning topic is TRANSPORT!
Can you recycle objects from around the house (i.e. cereal boxes, cardboard tubes, bottle tops etc) to make a vehicle of your choice.



Challenge 4

Can you make a map?
Choose a familiar journey and destination and make a map to help you find the way.

Challenge 5

Practise use of positional language such as in, on, under, in front, behind, inbetween, next to, above, below.
Model these words to your child as you travel ie, “our car is in front of a bus”.

Challenge 6

Maths- find different ways to make ten. Using ten objects of your choice ie, counters, toy people, pegs (anything!) make as many number bonds as you can
i.e. $1+9=10$, $2+8=10$,
 $3+7=10$, $4+6=10$, $5+5=10$

etc

Challenge 7

This half-term we will be discussing the importance of healthy eating. Using a paper plate or a blank piece of paper, can you design a healthy meal?

Challenge 8

Use as many types of transport over the next few weeks as you can. Walk, ride a bike, travel by train, tram, car or bus. Maybe you could think of another type of transport?
However you travel, talk about what you see and hear etc.
