Challenge 1

Phonics Practise – We have now covered all Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds. We are now consolidating all of these in class. Please see our website for all of the sounds and continue to practise them regularly at home.

Challenge 3

Our learning topic is MINIBEASTS! In a garden, park or other suitable outdoor space, have your own minibeast hunt. Use a magnifying glass if you have one and create a tally chart to show how many of each minibeast you find.



Challenge 4

Draw pictures of as many minibeasts as you can and label the picture with the name of the minibeast. Use your phonics to help you sound out the words.

Challenge 5

Can you make a bug hotel? Use flowers, grass, sticks, stones etc to make a cosy place for minibeasts to live.

Challenge 6

Maths- Draw a basic ladybird. Practise recalling double numbers by drawing the same number of spots on each wing.

Challenge 7

Maths-Continue to practise finding number bonds to 10 i.e. $1+9=10$
 $2+8=10$ etc.

Challenge 8

Very soon it will time to think about transition into Year 1. Reflect on the suorer year your child has had in Reception. Discuss all the things they have enjoyed and talk about what they are looking forward to in Year 1.
