Here are 8 Learning challenges: throughout this half term you must complete 6 of these challenges (1 challenge per week).

Please bring your completed challenges (if applicable) on the last week of the half term.

Be as creative and inventive as you can!

Please remember to read at least once a week.

Challenge 1

Make a pirate ship using junk modelling and different materials.

Can you include the parts of a pirate ship? (E.g. rigging, sails, crow's nest, port holes).

Challenge 2

Draw yourself as a pirate and give yourself a classic pirate name.

Can you add a speech bubble?

What would you say if you were a pirate?

Challenge 3

Research where pirates came from.

Which oceans did they use? Which countries did they go to?

Colour these on a map.



Challenge 4

Create your own treasure map.

Write some instructions on how to find your treasure. (E.g. how many steps forward?)

Challenge 5

Perry the pirate feels sad because he has a wooden leg, a hook and 1 eye.

Can you write him a letter to make him feel better about being different?



Challenge 6

Test which objects/materials you could use to create a pirate ship.

Do they float or sink?

Are they waterproof?

Challenge 7

Research a real-life historical pirate.

Create a WANTED poster including their name, picture, what they did and a reward.

Challenge 8

Design and create your own pirate flag that would go on your pirate ship.

Remember – your flag must be special and represent you!
