Start and Finish Times.

Children can arrive at school between 8.50 and 9.10am.



Year 2 finishes at 3.05pm on Monday to Thursday and at 1.20pm on a Friday (unless your child attends after school club on that day).

Reading Books.

 Book bags should come into school on a Monday morning containing 2 reading books and your child's reading diary. Please read with your child every week and sign or comment in the reading diary. Staff then know when books have been read and need to be changed.

Homework.

Maths and English homework is set every Wednesday on Seesaw to be completed by the following Wednesday. Work is also set on Seesaw for Friday afternoon due to the early finish. This is usually spellings and another activity. Paper copies of work can be provided if you have problems accessing Seesaw.



Forest Schools.

Forest school lessons take place on a Friday morning. Children should have suitable footwear and clothes for Forest School that you don't mind them getting dirty and muddy!
