<p>TEACHING STAFF</p> <p>2K's teacher is Mrs Kirkwood.</p> <p>2W's teachers are Miss Woolfenden (Monday-Thursday) and Mrs Martin (Friday).</p> <p>Mrs Roberts provides support across both classes.</p> <p>Miss Teale, Miss Mills and Mrs Serridge also provide additional support for individual children in year 2.</p>	<p>HOMEWORK</p> <p>Homework will be set on Seesaw, the on-line learning platform. Homework will be set each Wednesday to be completed by the following Wednesday. If you are unable to access Seesaw from home then please contact school by telephone and leave a message for your child's teacher. They will ring you back to discuss the best alternative arrangements for homework.</p>	<p>READING BOOKS.</p> <p>Every Monday your child will bring home their reading diary and two reading books in their book bag. Please listen to your child read these books over the next week. Please return the diary and the two books the following Monday. Please sign or comment in the diary to confirm your child has read so that staff know the books need to be changed.</p>
<p>FOREST SCHOOL</p> <p>Every Friday the children will need a change of clothing and wellies for their forest school lesson. Our forest school area can often be wet and muddy so old clothes are more suitable and it is a good idea to bring in spare socks and underwear.</p> 	<p>P.E.</p> <p>2K will be doing P.E. on Tuesday and Thursday. 2W will be doing P.E. on Tuesday and Thursday.</p> <p>All children must have an indoor and outdoor P.E. kit in school. Indoor kit should include shorts and T-shirt. Outdoor kit should include legging/joggers and a hoodie/sweatshirt. Pumps/trainers should also be provided. All kit should be labelled with your child's name. P.E. kits should be in a small drawstring bag. School are able to provide these bags if needed.</p>	<p>BAGS AND BELONGINGS</p> <p>We can't have large bags and back packs in school. Children should bring in suitable outdoor coats and packed lunches (if applicable) every day. On a Monday morning your child should also bring in their book bag and water bottles every day.</p>
