English

In phonics this week we are starting Phase 2. We are learning the first 4 letter sounds; s, a, t, p.

We are looking at the sound these letters make not the letter name.

We will find lots of pictures/objects that begin with those sounds.

We will continue revising our Phase 1 work that we did in Nursery. We are doing lots of alliteration activities, talking like a robot and sounding out words, and having a go at hearing and saying the first sound in words.

Maths


This week we are introducing the numbers 1, 2 and 3.

We will be learning to count objects/ actions eg drum beats and claps.

We will be looking at the numerals and arrays for 1, 2 and 3.

We will have a go at ordering amounts of objects and counting objects out from a larger group.

We will also introduce the words 'more' and 'less'.
